In Saikheda, the meeting primarily focused on reviewing the progress of the sewerage project and the Narmada drinking water scheme. Chief Municipal Officer Mr. Jai Prakash Rajak informed that households yet to receive water connections will be identified and provided connections at the earliest to ensure drinking water supply to every home. Meanwhile, Project Manager, PIU Jabalpur, Mr. Gopal Gupta directed that the pending sewer connections be completed on priority after obtaining necessary approvals from the municipal authorities.

The meeting was attended by the Ward No. 15 Councillor, other public representatives, contractors, and concerned officials. The meeting was coordinated by Community Development Officer Ms. Aparajita Mishra.

Similarly, in Alampur, Daboh, and Mihona, meetings reviewed the progress of various development works and emphasized maintaining quality and adhering to timelines. Officials and staff were directed to ensure time-bound resolution of complaints so that better services can be delivered to the public.

Officials present included Community Development Officer Ms. Sonika Sharma and Engineer Yogendra Singh from Madhya

Pradesh Urban Development Company, along with Amit Rathore and Deepak representing the contractor. Engineers and other concerned officials of the Municipal Councils also attended the meetings.

Authorities instructed all concerned to complete project works within stipulated timelines and ensure that no negligence occurs in addressing citizens' issues.
