# 11 Water Samples Collected to Investigate Pollution in Gambhir River from Pithampur Industrial Area



**Acting** on the directions of Urban Development and Housing Commissioner Shri Sanket Bhondwe, a team of senior officials conducted an inspection on Monday following complaints regarding pollution in the Gambhir River allegedly caused by industrial discharge from the Pithampur industrial area in Dhar district.



The inspection team included MPUDC EnC Anand Singh, environmental expert Dr. Sitaram Tagore, Project Manager D.R. Lodhi, along with the Chief Municipal Officer of Pithampur and experts from the Pollution Control Board. During the visit, the team inspected several locations around the Pithampur industrial area, including Chirakhan Nala, Kalaria, Betma Anicut, Mhow village, and Yashwant Sagar, to assess the condition of the Gambhir River and related water sources.



As part of the investigation into possible industrial pollution, a total of 11 water samples were collected from different locations and have been sent to a laboratory for testing. Further action will be taken based on the findings of the laboratory report. After this, ENC Shri Anand Singh also inspected the water supply project of Mandav Nagar.

## MPUDC Organizes Fire Safety Training for Workers under National Safety Week.
